



Undergraduate Research Assistant Matching Funds: Fall Application

Undergraduate research is a critically important aspect of our education, training, and research mission and the Department of Geological Sciences (DGS) is committed to providing financial support to hire undergraduate research assistants (URAs). The Fall application will be evaluated starting October 1, 2021 and considered until funds are exhausted. Another call will be announced in the Spring of 2022 if funds remain.

This call requests applications for matching funds (50%) for the employment of DGS URAs. Matching funds are limited to 10 hours/week at the JSG-approved URA rate of \$12.75/hour and to a total of a dozen proposals each year. The internal application requires identification of a student, an existing funding source for matching student support, and a brief description of both research position and mentoring plan. Faculty are eligible for one award/year.
